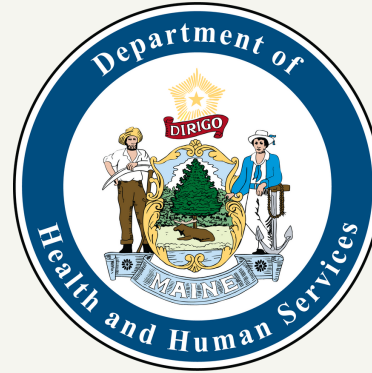

What is SCSEP?

The Senior Community Service Employment Program provides an opportunity for training in a work environment to support older adults re-entering the workforce. This program is designed to assist participants in transitioning to *unsubsidized* employment through part-time on the job work training at a local non-profit organization or government entity. We help focus efforts more effectively to develop skills and behaviors that result in greater employability for all SCSEP participants.

- Complete application with SCSEP staff or submit completed application to SCSEP.OADS@maine.gov
- Work with the SCSEP staff to complete an Individualized Employment Plan (IEP). The IEP identifies your career goals and the skills necessary to achieving that specified career.
- SCSEP staff will assign you a host organization where you will begin your community service assignment. The host organization you are placed at will align with the skills identified in your IEP.
- Community service work-training assignments length varies as you learn and gain skills. SCSEP participants have a 48 month life-time durational limit.
